Bluff Head is an invaluable geological site to study the 400 million years of age sedimentary rocks undergoing significant earth movements and weathering.

We strongly urge all visitors to stop climbing devil's fist. Climbing would easily damage the fist and endanger our own lives as the sedimentary rocks might easily fall apart as the rocks have been seriously weathered.

We urge the Agriculture, Fisheries and Conservation Department to tighten their patrolling. We urge the travellers not to climb the fist any more. Keep the fist intact and leave it to our next generations.
